#### December 6, 2022

Meeting called to order Maitland @ 7:00 p.m., Five (5) Board members present.

Pledge of Allegiance said

Approval of Meeting Agenda: Motion to approve November 1, 2022 Meeting Agenda as presented made by Stanley, second by Sheldon. Motion carried.

Approval of November 1, 2022 Meeting Minutes: Motion to approve November 1, 2022 Meeting Minutes made by Murray, second by Maitland. Motion carried.

Approval of November 2022 Treasurer's report: **Sheldon(**Treasurer) advised that tax collection has slowed down and about 7.34% are uncollected at this time. **Maitland(**Supervisor) asked if those taxpayers now have to pay the taxes at the County Treasurer's office. **Sheldon(**Treasurer) advised she would still collect these taxes until the end of February/1<sup>st</sup> of March. **Motion to approve November 2022 Treasurer's Report made by Murray, second by Stanley. Motion carried.** 

Approval of November 2022 bills:

Motion to approve November 2022 bills (Township bills \$19,720.07) made by Maitland, second by Murray(Fire Dept. bills \$854.35) made Murray, second by Stanley, (Township payroll \$4,543.75) made by Sheldon, second by Maitland). Motion carried.

Fire Report: Jeff Withey( Assistant Fire Chief) read Fire Chief Stone's(Absent) report:

There were two calls in November

The ceiling fans are installed in the fire hall to combat the moisture issues.

The issue with the heat was an accidental grounding of a wire by the electricians while installing the fans. The problem is taken care of now. AC/DC came out and fixed their mistake. We should not see a bill on this. Carter Mechanical came out initially for the no heat issue but advised that couldn't help and that we needed an electrician.

There are no updates on the grants at this time. **Withey**(Assistant Fire Chief) advised he applied for a Micro grant from a private foundation for 5-mini thermal imaging cameras.

I have terminated probationary firefighter **Brandon Zwiernik** for lack of participation and not fulfilling his probationary requirements.

We have acquired the replacement hose for the grass rig. We will be going through the grass rig skid unit this off season as it needs freshening up so to speak.

<u>Planning Report</u>: Steinhoff(Planning Commission Chairman) advised the last meeting was October 11, 2022. The two new Planning Commission members are Andrew Schuster and Bill McClarty and they were given the ordinance book. Next meeting will be held January 10, 2022 and plans to put together an advisory committee for solar & wind ordinance input.

Zoning Report: Sproul(Zoning Administrator) absent

Old Business:

Approval of AC DC Electrical Contractors, LLC bid for Fire hall ceiling fans:

Maitland(Supervisor) read the bid document for 6 ceilings fans that were installed in the Speaker Township fire hall. Motion to approve payment to AC DC Electrical Contractors, LLC i in the amount of \$3,734.40 made by Murray, second by Stanley. Motion carried

**New Business:** 

Approve Tax Assessor Contract Addendum #2:

Maitland(Supervisor) explained that Tax Assessor Shelly Baumeister requested that she be allowed to have her husband, Alan Baumeister approved as her deputy so she has someone to respond out to properties, etc. with her. Maitland(Supervisor) read the Contract Addendum #2 that will be attached to the current tax assessing contract thru March 31, 2023 emphasis on no monetary changes in the contract. Motion to approve the Tax Assessor Contract Addendum #2 made by Sheldon, second by Stanley. Roll Call Vote: AYES: Sheldon, Stanley, Maitland, Cubitt & Murray: NAYS: 0. Motion carried.

Approve Roadside Ditch Improvement Agreement Mike Noll Parker RD/Wellman Line RD:

Maitland(Supervisor) presented the Roadside Ditch Improvement Agreement from the Sanilac County Road Commission. The township share of the cost will be in the amount of \$1,226.00. Motion to Approve the Roadside Ditch Improvement Agreement with the Sanilac County Road Commission & Mike Noll made by Maitland, second by Stanley. Motion carried.

<u>Public Comment</u>: (Present: SEE ATTACHED SIGNATURE PAGES FOR ATTENDEES)

Maitland(Supervisor) advised Public comment would be limited to 3 minutes per person and requested for those able to respond to the podium and use the microphone. Carolyn Fairman(Public) responded to the podium and read a statement advising the Township Board has a responsibility to represent all of the township and not just the residents that signed up with the wind mill company. Her husband held up a map that she put together showing that a small portion of the township is getting wind mills put in. Went on to say she and her sister had responded up to Huron County where the wind mills currently operate on a windy day and drove around for 3 hours. Stated instantly stared to feel pressure in ears, headache and nausea from the noise and shadow flicker. Suffered from ringing in her ears for a few days after. Started feeling better when about 10 miles away. The noise sounds like a jet plane.

Concerned that once installed in Speaker Township she will not able to go outside to work in yard, etc. She might possibly have to move. Requests Township Board votes "No" when the time comes. Maitland (Supervisor) asked if Fairman(Public) if she had received a copy of the letter from her source Byron Neal

that she quoted in a previous meeting. **Fairman**(Public) stated that she did not say he was an expert but that it was his opinion. **Maitland**(Supervisor) advised she would be provided with a copy after the meeting.

Denise Jones (Public) approached the podium and read information regarding a realtor and the impact of windmills on property values. Believes the expert at the Fremont township meetings was giving false information. Discussed PFAS chemicals for waterproofing that is on the propellers of the windmills that flakes off on the ground seeps into the soil and causes health issues. Encouraged the Township Board to do research at EPA.gov. Maitland (Supervisor) asked if Jones (Public) had called EGLE to which she stated she did and left a message with no return call as of yet. Maitland (Supervisor) stated that EGLE will address any issues or concerns that may affect the township environment. Jones (Public) I mentioned "Common Law" and how windmill companies are losing and settling out of court

Concerns by the Public that Liberty Power has not answered the questions that have been submitted to them. **Maitland**(Supervisor) stated that the Board is waiting as well for questions to be answered.

Marilyn Strickler(Public) approached the podium and read a statement that in regards to she and Fairman(Public) traveling to Huron County to listen to the windmills and the health effects that were encountered. The noise was loud like tennis shoes in a dryer. She stressed that the Board members are being lied to and the township board and should go door to door to talk with people. Presented a printout of literature on InfraRed Capital Partners to Maitland(Supervisor). Strickler(Public) stated that people in the township do not like Tom Murray(Trustee). Maitland(Supervisor) stated that he had been in Huron County windmill area for about 6 hours when the winds were 30 mph and only heard a whoosh. Even saw Eagles in the area. Strickler(Public) stated that she only saw two deer in the 3 hours she was in Huron County and no dead deer on the road and found that very strange as there are deer everywhere in Sanilac County and alongside the road. Pathic(Public) stated he has a home in Caseville and he noticed on the way home that on the side of the road where the windmills were located there were no geese but across the road where there were a bunch of geese in the field.

Susan Davies (Public) approached the podium and stated that on October 12, 2022 she and her husband responded to area of the Riverbend Wind Project in Huron County. Winds were 30 to 35 mph and did not hear the noise. Some of the windmills were shut down. Electrical crews were working on the inside. Project possibly up going in February. Davies (Public) stated she did not experience any health issues while at the site. She went on to say that was disappointed with the website that was started by Mark from Fremont as it was supposed to be a place for those against and for the windmill project to share info. It was become derogatory. She went on to discuss definitions of greed and ignorance and the process that took place before she and her husband signed a contract. The data being presented is not relevant that is being posted and will not change people's minds.

Other public members spoke from their seats asking about the Safety Data sheets and why they have not yet been provided by Liberty Power. Maitland(Supervisor) stated they have to provide them as part of the special land use permit and if they do not the permit will not be approved. Concern was over migraines that could be caused to those already suffering with the condition. Maitland(Supervisor) stated this could be addressed at the Public Hearing. Discussion on politicians wanting an alternative for energy sources and it would be best for the township to handle the issue before the State steps in. Also, discussion on letting the State come in and handle the green energy issue and the township would then

be off the hook. Discussion held on how it would not be in the best interest for the State to come in and take over. Discussion on how the windmill companies damage the tiling in the fields and wont' fix it. Others stated it is in the contracts that the windmills companies will fix and repair any damage to the tile.

Motion to Adjourn meeting @ 8:23 p.m. made by Murray, second by Sheldon. Motion carried.
