

Speaker Township Board Meeting Minutes

January 3, 2023

Meeting called to order Maitland @7:00 p.m. Four (4) Board Members present. Clerk Cubitt was out for medical reasons.

Pledge of Allegiance said.

Approval of Meeting Agenda: **Motion to approve January 3, 2022 Meeting Agenda was presented made by Murray and seconded by Stanley. Motion Carried.**

Approval of December 6, 2022, Meeting Minutes: **Motion to approve December 6, 2022, Meeting Minutes made by Maitland, second by Stanley. Motion Carried.**

Approval of the December 2022 Treasurer's Report: **Motion to approve December's 2022 Treasurer's Report made by Murray, seconded by Maitland. Motion Carried.**

Approval of December 2022 Bills: **Motion to approve December 2022 (Township Bills \$1,7853.35) made by Stanley, seconded by Sheldon. Motion carried. (Fire Dept. Bills \$4,662.81) Supervisor Maitland explained the new fans in the fire hall was a large portion of Decembers Fire Department Bills. Motion to approve by Murray, seconded by Sheldon. Motion Carried. (Twp. Payroll \$5,87625) Motion made by Stanley, seconded by Murray. Motion carried.**

Fire Report: Trevor submitted report via email. We ended the year with 39 run totals. We have made it through the first step in the process for a small grant from the Gary Sinese Foundation. This grant is for thermal imaging. To move onto the second phase, we need to provide the fire department budget with it's expenditures listed. So, I will need some assistance with this. Supervisor Maitland stated that Clerk Cubitt would be able to help provide this information.

I would like to offer Jesse Withey a position as a probationary fire fighter. Jesse is already trained and has several years of experience with Elk Twp Fire. Jesse is not leaving Elk he is just wanting to help us out as he understands all local fire departments have manpower issues especially during the daytime hours. I

however do not have his background check back yet as the person who does this at the Sheriff's Department is on vacation. However, I am confident his information will come back fine as he is current with Elk Twp and I know they do their due diligence with background checks. I am asking permission to offer him the position. Murray made a motion to approve the assignment of Jesse Withey pending background check. Maitland seconded. Motion carried.

I continue to follow the FEMA grant awards in hope that we will be selected. But as we have discussed before I fear our need to replace SCBA's may need to happen regardless of the grant. Maitland explained that these SCBA'S are air packs. They are approx. \$11,000-\$12,000 each. The total cost is approximately \$90,000.00. They have acquired a couple from Brockway that they are using for parts. Maitland agreed that a discussion is needed on getting the Fire Department that equipment that is needed.

Motion made by Murray to approve the appointment of Jesse Whitney to the Speaker Township Fire Department pending background check results. Seconded by Maitland. Motion carried.

Planning Report: Chairman Ben Steinhoff was not present. Maitland explained that the next meeting for the Planning Commission will be Tuesday, January 11th at 7 pm.

Zoning Report: Bonnie explained it was quiet month. Pam Watkins wants to do a land split off 4 acres of her property on Jordan Rd. Application was given.

David Holden had questions about putting a house on property.

Old Business: No old business to discuss

New Business: Motion to approve 2023 Monthly Board Meeting Dates. Motion made by Murray and seconded by Stanley. Motion Carried. Meeting dates to be put on door of Township Hall and added to the Website.

Township Supervisor Maitland introduced and welcomed State Senator Dan Lauwers to address the attendees. Senator Lauwers stated that he was requested at this meeting due to the concerns regarding wind energy. Senator Lauwers stated that he had no opinion on wind energy. He did however state that there are Two (2) big considerations regarding wind energy/turbines.

- 1) Economic Impact. - It can and will bring a lot of tax revenue to local areas.
- 2) Personal Property Right Issues- We must respect people's property rights. Also, we need to consider the impacts that are made to our neighbors.

Senator Lauwers also stated that Speaker Township Residence do not want the State to mandate the regulations for local townships. It is much harder to get your opinion and concerns heard at a State Level. He also stated that you don't get better results when the state steps in. You get better representation by the Township Government than you're going to get at the State Level.

Several attendees addressed the Senator with concerns that they face with the Township Ordinance for Wind Turbines. Setbacks, Health Issues, Height of the Wind Turbines expected in Speaker Township, and the Mega Watts that these turbines will generate. Senator Lauwers explained that he was not familiar with Speaker Township Ordinance and declined to offer comment.

Supervisor Maitland thanked Senator Lauwers for attending the meeting.

County Commissioner John Moody was introduced by Supervisor Maitland. Commissioner Moody did a brief synopsis of the County Commissioner Meeting held earlier today. He explained it was an organizational meeting. John Block was named Chairman. He also explained that Forrester Park will be doing a \$232,000 upgrade. Money is coming from trust, grants, and park millage. This will upgrade the playground and equipment.

Public Comment:

Maitland opened the floor to public comment. He asked that everyone be respectful.

Several attendees spoke and raised concerns regarding the Wind Turbines. It was asked if the Safety Data Sheets were available from Liberty. Supervisor Maitland explained that he has requested them but has not received them. He did, however, explain that he received the report from Vestis. Vestis has studied the ordinance and put their stamp of approval on the project.

Carolyn Fairman- stated that FMEA Director Todd Hillman can demand the SDS Sheets. She stated that he will be requesting them.

Concerns about people with medical conditions (Seizures) and what affect the Turbines will have on their health. It was stated that a gentleman in Fremont Township that has been Seizure free for 35 years was informed by his doctor to move if the wind turbines are coming in. He found out that he couldn't get full value of his land due to the Wind Turbines coming into the township.

Literature was handed out regarding black shale found while digging wells. So, the concern is what will happen once they start digging for the wind turbines.

Setbacks were discussed and it was stated that the state has a stricter setback than Speaker Township. Also, Fremont Township has a stricter setback as well.

Conflict of interest regarding the Township Board was mentioned. Mary Angerbrandt stated that the Township Board and Township Attorney have an ethical obligation to represent the citizens of Speaker Township. She went on to state that a meeting was held for the Planning Commission where Liberty Lawyers and members of the Planning Committee changed the ordinance to accommodate Liberty. She stated that Thomas Vore, Oliver Netter, Tom Murray, Ben Steinhoff, Bernie Davies and Ken Dambacher were present at this meeting. Then two days later there was a public hearing. She wanted to know how the ordinance could be changed in two days and who made the motion and who seconded it. She stated she requested this information and was told that no documentation existed.

Board Member Tom Murray explained that he could not recall such a meeting taking place with Liberty Lawyers.

Supervisor Maitland addressed missing document accusations and it was his understanding that there was a point and time where there was a transition of secretaries and fill-ins were appointed to take down minutes. He thought that all minutes had been located but would investigate it.

Board Member Sheldon wanted to make it perfectly clear that the Planning Commission is the one they will ultimately make the recommendations regarding the Special Land Use Permit submitted by Liberty.

Newly appointed Planning Committee Member Bill McLarty spoke up and stated that he will need to gather all the information regarding the above-mentioned comments. He wants to verify that all requirements were met at the township level regarding meetings and documentation. He will investigate the State requirements versus the township requirements. He also expressed that we need to work together to make the most appropriate recommendations.

Supervisor Maitland stated that a Special Land Use Permit has been submitted and the Engineer and Lawyer have been reviewing the Special Land Use Application. They are ready to submit their reports. Once that happens the Planning Committee will hold a Public Meeting.

Adjournment:

Murray made a motion to adjourn meeting at 8:19 pm. Sheldon seconded. Motion carried.






