

Speaker Township Board Meeting Minutes

April 4, 2023

Meeting called to order **Maitland** @ 7:00 p.m., Five (5) Board members present.

Approval of Meeting Agenda:

Cubitt(Clerk) requested the meeting agenda be amended under New Business to move item #2 to item #1 to allow **Grant Burgess**(Sexton) the opportunity to talk about contract for excavating and to introduce **Mark Zielinski** as he will be contracting with township for the footing/headstone placement at the Speaker Township Cemetery. **Motion to approve March 16, 2023 Meeting Agenda with amendments as presented made by Maitland, second by Murray. Motion carried.**

Approval of March 16, 2023 Meeting Minutes: **Motion to approve March 16, 2023 Meeting Minutes made by Murray, second by Sheldon. Motion carried.**

Approval of March 2023 Treasurer's report: **Sheldon**(Treasurer) advised the fire millage fund was closed and funds transferred into the Fire General fund for use in the purchase of the air packs. The Riverbend Project Reimbursement account was set up under that account number. The tax account will not see much activity until July when summer taxes go out. County Treasurer will be sending delinquent funds as collected. **Maitland**(Supervisor) asked if tax payments now have to be made with the County Treasurer and **Sheldon**(Clerk) confirmed the same. **Motion to approve March 2023 Treasurer's Report made by Maitland, second by Stanley. Motion carried.**

Planning Report: Steinhoff(Planning Commission) advised the quarterly Planning Commission meeting is being held on Tuesday, April 11, 2023 @ 7:00 p.m and the meeting notice will be posted. Agenda items include approval of previous meeting minutes, input from Advisory Committee, compliance issues on campground, election of 2023/2024 officers and solar ordinance amendments.

Zoning Report: Sproul(Zoning Administrator)(SEE ATTACHED) read her attached report.

Advised a slow month. On the report it was mentioned about someone looking to put in a pond and Maitland(Supervisor) asked about the ordinance and Sproul(Zoning Administrator) advised there is an ordinance in regards to ponds.

Cemetery Excavating Contract/Headstone Footing Contract:

Cubitt(Clerk) asked Grant Burgess to introduce **Mark A. Zielinski** and explain that he will only be conducting the excavating services at the cemetery and he is turning the footing implementation and headstone placement services over to him. **Maitland**((Supervisor) advised there are now two separate contracts with the same pricing as previous year. **Motion to approve Speaker Township Excavating Services contract with Grant Burgess Excavating, LLC made by Maitland, second by Murray. Motion carried. Motion to approve Speaker Township Footing Installation and Head Stone Placement Services with Mark A. Zielinski made by Maitland, second by Sheldon. Motion carried.**

Approve Fremont Township Fire Protection Contract:

Maitland(Supervisor) presented the Fremont Township Fire Protection Contract. Review of the increase in the amount per section per the Speaker Township Fire Chief. The contract covers a two year period. **Motion to Approve the Fremont Township Fire Protection Contract made by Maitland, second by Sheldon. Motion carried.**

Referendum Petition on Wind Overlay Amendment 2023-01

Cubitt(Clerk) presented a letter from **Carolyn Fairman** that was in an envelope laying on the table at the clerk's position. **Maitland**(Supervisor) read the Notice of Intent to File Referendum Petitions from **Carolyn Fairman** (SEE ATTACHED). **Maitland**(Supervisor) asked **Carolyn Fairman** if she understood what this means to which she stated that she did. Debbie McClarty(Public) came forward asking **Maitland**(Supervisor) to explain why he asked that question to **Carolyn Fairman**. **Maitland**(Supervisor) stated he asked the question to make sure that **Carolyn Fairman** knew what she was doing.

Public Comment:

Maitland(Supervisor) stated the Township would hear public comment but only one item per person and no longer than 5 minutes.

Dwight Bartle(Public) approached the podium talking about Trespass Zoning and the value of his property. He had been at the Board of Review and has asked for lower property taxes based on the wind turbine project. Maitland(Supervisor) stated he was told at the Board of Review that he had not filled out a petition. He asked who was responsible for the Trespass Zoning and he was advised it came from the Planning Commission. **Bartle**(Public) asked about who pays the legal fees in relation to the wind turbines and who is paying for the cost of the recall election. Maitland(Supervisor) said there is an escrow account set up for the legal costs and we hire our own vendors. The recall election costs are paid by the township.

Rella Hoffman(Public) approached the podium and asked if the safety data sheets have been received. Maitland(Supervisor) stated the public hearing was not set yet and the safety data sheets have not been received. She asked if the public hearing was next Tuesday. Cubitt(Clerk) advised that was the Planning Commission meeting and the public hearing would be set by the Planning Commission.
